











Hohe Tauern National Park - Basic Data








Hohe Tauern National Park Salzburg Part - Basic Data






buffer zone

maintenance and sustainable management of a traditionally cultivated landscape for the *conservation of a high biological diversity*










core zone

ensuring the unrestricted action of geomorphological, ecological and evolutionary processes without human interference











wilderness zone
