



What is a manifesto?

Several definitions:

- "a written statement declaring publicly the intentions, motives, or views of its issue"
- "a public statement stating your views or your intention to do something"

What is our message?

- We want to protect and conserve our environment.
- We need to create more selfsufficient, diverse rural communities across Europe
- We want to connect to each other, across generations and share our ideas
