Ecologist's view: a shoreline is a zone with interesting geomofological features and high biodiversity values.


Architect`s view: a shoreline is man made waterfront, an architectural element with straight lines and strict forms.



Finnish NUP Concept - from vision to practice: III Legislation

68 § A National urban park (Land Use and Building Act 132/1999)

A national urban park may be established to <u>protect and maintain</u> the *biodiversity (2009)* and beauty of the cultural and natural landscape, historical characteristics or related values concerning the townscaping, social, recreational or other <u>special values</u> of an area in an

Each site must meet four technical criteria (I-IV)







Finnish NUP Concept - from vision to practice: II The first vision

The first Finnish National Urban Park was established in 2001 in Hämeenlinna on the basis of the 1997 vision. At the time, we had no legislation for national urban parks.

Vision of 1997




Outline of the 2001 Decision of the NUP

The growing network of NUPs in Finland 2019





NUP in Land Use and Building Act (132/1999) 70 §

THE VALUES OF A NUP ARE MANAGED BY A MANAGEMENT PLAN



Boundaries and the main objects of management in Hämeenlinna NUP






VI Finnish NUP Concept - from vision to practice: Impelementation of the management plan.

The transformation of the former industrial lake shore into a connective trail/ecological corridor between railwaystation and Aulanko area.












Finnish NUP Concept - from vision to practice: VII Impelementation of the management plan. The end result is a species rich ecological corridor with beautiful historical landscape views.




Coexistence between nature conservation and intangible heritage: Natura 2000 Site/Sibelius Forest Nature Reserve 2018.


View from Sibelius Forest Nature Reserve to the Aulanko ancient castle mountain / Aulanko Nature Reserve

It is permissible for berries and mushrooms to be picked up throughout the national urban park on the basis of everyone's rights.







IX What we can learn from Finnish NUP concept?


