The LIFE NaturAdapt project

- The project aims at proposing tools for PA managers to take climate change into account in their practices.
- It is also designed to enhance the context in which PA managers have to evolve and carry out adaptation measures.
- Decision makers are clearly a target in that way.



The ongoing white paper

- A white paper is to be published at the European scale to explain PA managers' needs to decision makers.
- It is currently the *Task Force*'s main work



The process

- Defining our common values, "where we stand"
- Assessing PAs' situation towards climate change through a SWOT analysis, as a basis for the white paper content
- Identifying who exactly we aim for and for what purpose(s)
- Writing the content of the white paper



The process

To begin with, we agreed on our common values, "where we stand"



1. Nature is endangered, climate change makes it even more pressing to protect and restore it.



2. A healthy nature is a condition for developing our societies and reaching sustainable development goals. The economy is not possible without nature.



3. There is an opportunity:

- to put Nature higher on the political agenda;
- to rethink the role for protected areas and the way we manage them.



4. Protected areas networks are a critical part of the solution : they provide scientific knowledge, experiment innovative approaches, secure the benefits of nature to people, etc.



5. Protected areas shouldn't do it alone. Caring for Nature is a collective responsibility and ought to be done collaboratively.
