


SITE AND USER ANALYSIS











FALL LINE TRAIL + EROSION OF TRAIL BED AND RUNOFF IN WATER COURSES








BENCH-CUT SIDESLOPE TRAIL → WATER SHEETS ACROSS TRAIL **GRADE REVERSAL**




GRADE REVERSALS + ENSURES WATER STAYS OUT OF TREAD


