

Cross-border watercourses management


- Landscapes, biodiversity and ecosystems are based on water
- The EGTC doesn't have proper competencies regarding water management
- 3 case studies to illustrate the differences between international agreements; between French and Belgian regulation and the lack of cross-border maintenance coordination.





Legal and administrative obstacle

- Legal and administrative asymmetry between French and Walloon rivercourses management.
- No legal obligation of cross-border cooperation, which is purely voluntary.
- This generates tensions between the stakeholders (misunderstanding and ignorance of the functioning of both administrations).







Possible Solutions

- Calling upon the States on the need to set up the European mechanism for cross-border cooperation (ECBM)
- Amend French and Belgian laws to force cooperation with partners.
- Experiment the drafting of management plans for transboundary rivers/basins.
- Promote cultural/administrative inter-knowledge and guide the coordination of partners.



2- How will we base our future actions on regarding the findings ?





- Inter-knowledge is the key to keep working on the dynamic but need to bring together French and Belgian managers on operational aspects.
- Focus on small scale experiments, both in terms of the issue addressed, space, stakeholders engaged and where tensions are absent.
