Consultation Platforms


Administrators consult stakeholders before they make a decision

Stakeholders make decisions within a system set up by administrators




A definition of a cooperation platform

- Communication and cooperation
- Understanding; trust; recognition
- Solutions; good practices
- Legitimacy
- Empowerment
- Networking

WHEN A PLATFORM IS THE WRONG APPROACH

- Previous efforts failed
- Local and regional administrations do not commit
- Local and regional administrations opting for full control
- Political situation highly dynamic
- Little local demand
- Key stakeholders refuse to engage
- Trust levels too low
- Approach culturally inappropriate
- Funding will run out during the process

GETTING STARTED

- Initiator; participants; goal
- Geographical scale
- Resources needed
- Roles and responsibilities (organisers; participants; facilitators)
- Mandate and decisionmaking power (Authorities)

PREPARING AND PLANNING

- Socio-cultural context
- Stakeholder mapping
- Evaluate conflict situation
- Power imbalances
- Representation





IMPLEMENTATION

- Group size
- Transparency
- Communication ground rules
- Expectations
- Facilitation needed
- Setting
- Organization

Key takeaways

- From "communication" to participatory processes; facilitation/mediation
- Institutionalization of stakeholder interaction and joint action; platforms
- Stakeholder interaction/collaboration even under ongoing tension/conflict
- Varying degree of stakeholder ownership
- Varying degree of control of results by stakeholders
- Aim to let stakeholders interact and work together on the ground
