- Greatest environmental threats:

- Climate change and biodiversity loss are interconnected
 - Without climate protection and climate change adaptation there is no protection of the biodiversity and vice versa
- Global issues require joint action

- Develop and invest in NRL Parks to support measures on biodiversity and climate protection

- Support NRL Parks in their educational and communication programs and actions







We call upon policymakers to ...

- Support NRL Parks to involve young, committed, climate-aware people
- Involve NRL Parks at a European and regional level in climate action planning
- Integrate strategic orientation of Parks and Protected Areas in funding programs
- Include Parks and Protected Areas as target groups in funding calls
