

EU Habitats Directive (1979)

Art. 4: Priority to maintain or restore natural habitats at a favourable conservation status...



THE BIODIVERSITY PLAN

CBD Global Biodiversity Framework (2022)

TARGET 2: Ensure that by 2030 at least 30% of areas of degraded terrestrial, inland water, and coastal and marine ecosystems are under effective restoration...







Bern Convention – Strategic Plan for Action to 2030 (2023)

Target 1.1: Natural and semi-natural ecosystems are maintained and where possible **restored** or rehabilitated, leading to an overall increase in area, connectivity, integrity and resilience.

EU Nature Restoration Regulation

EU Biodiversity Strategy to 2030 (May 2020) EC proposal (June 2022)




EU Nature Restoration Regulation

EU countries must restore:

- At least 30% of habitats in poor condition by 2030, 60% by 2040, and 90% by 2050
- Priority to Natura 2000 until 2030
- Ensure no deterioration of restored areas
- National Restoration plans to be adopted by MS















Specific targets for:

- Agricultural ecosystems (might be suspended under exceptional circumstances)
- Drained peatlands restoration (30% by 2030...)
- Forest ecosystems + three planting (3BLN)
- Free flowing rivers (25.000 km)
- Urban and peri-urban green spaces



Not all is solved:

Restoration is expensive... but pays back (1€ = €8)

Controversial

Can't ignore productive land

Engagement of landowners, farmers, land managers, users...

Planning, planning, planning
Monitoring and assessment are crucial
Restoration cannot happen only in Natura
2000/PAs





EUROPARC committed to support PAs for RESTORATION:
