FIELD WORKSHOP: DAY 1

GROUP 1, MODERATED BY KRNAP:

Karkonoska Pass area

This excursion explores the Karkonosze Mountains, a vital cross-border region between Poland and the Czech Republic. Guided by experts, participants will discuss conservation efforts for black grouse, tourism challenges with private entities in sensitive areas, visitor management in high-traffic zones, and the region's unique flora and fauna. A mountain hut lunch will offer insights into overtourism's impact on these delicate ecosystems.

Szrenica Mt. and Jakuszyce area

This excursion ascends Szrenica Mountain in the western Karkonosze, ending in Jakuszyce, renowned for hiking and cross-country skiing. Led by specialists, topics include sustainable trail management across seasons, balancing tourism development with ecological connectivity, and the buffer zone's role in visitor flow regulation. The route offers panoramic Sudetes views and insights into managing recreational pressures while preserving ecological integrity. Lunch at Jakuszyce's Biathlon Centre will facilitate discussions on overtourism's impact in these sensitive areas.

About the Venue

Sobieszów Palace is a beautifully renovated 18th/19th-century manor-palace complex, now transformed into a modern educational and event space within Karkonosze National Park. This historic site provides an inspiring backdrop for transboundary cooperation, nature conservation, and sustainable tourism discussions.

Facilities

- Main Conference Room: accommodates up to 150 participants
- Two Workshop Rooms: capacity of 34 and 40 people
- On-Site Parking: space for 36 cars, 5 buses, and 2 designated spots for people with disabilities

The venue is surrounded by stunning natural landscapes, making it an ideal location to immerse yourself in the themes of conservation and sustainable tourism while enjoying the rich cultural and historical atmosphere of the region.

Transport: The Concordia Hotel is 7 km from the Nature and Education Center in Sobieszów, with a shuttle bus service for participants to and from the meeting venue.

Room Rates (Bed & Breakfast):

- Shared Room (2/3/4 persons): €50 per person/day
- Single Room (limited availability): €60 per person/day

Participants are responsible for their own accommodation payments. However, the organisers will assist with the reservation process to ensure a smooth stay.

PARTICIPATION FEE

The participation fee is €370 per person, covering:

- Shuttle transport to Karkonosze National Park (KPN) by bus from two airports and during an event.
- Lunches and dinners (9.06.2025 ice breaker, 10.06.2025 lunch and dinner, 11.06.2025 lunch only). Dinners (9-11.06.2025) are covered for participants at Concordia Hotel.
- Meeting materials and conference resources

Participants are responsible for accommodation costs, which are separate from the participation fee.

HOW TO ARRIVE

By Plane

Participants can fly into:

Shuttle Service will be provided from both Wrocław and Prague airports to the Concordia Hotel. Exact shuttle schedules will be shared closer to the event.

For those unable to take the shuttle:

By Train

- From Wrocław Main Railway Station, take a train to Jelenia Góra Sobieszów (approx. 2.5 hours).
- From Sobieszów train station, it's a 10-minute walk to the Sobieszów Palace.

By Bus

- Take a bus from Wrocław Bus Station (ul. Sucha 1/11) to Jelenia Góra Bus Station (ul. Obrońców Pokoju 1B).
- From Jelenia Góra, take a local bus from "Podwale" stop (near Galeria Nowy Rynek) to Pałac Sobieszów.
- Total travel time: Approx. 3 hours from Wrocław

By Car

- Take National Road No. 3, then turn towards Sobieszów in Piechowice – Pakoszów.
- Distance from main road to Sobieszów Palace: 3.6 km.
