## **TB Definitions**

1. A Transboundary
Protected Area is a clearly
defined geographical space that
is comprised of protected areas
that are ecologically connected
across one or more international
boundaries and is under some

form of cooperation.






2. A **Transboundary Conservation Landscape and/or Seascape** is an ecologically connected area that sustains ecological processes and crosses one or more international boundaries, and which includes protected areas as well as multiple resource use areas, and is under some form of cooperation.

3. **Transboundary Migration Conservation Areas** are wildlife habitats that are necessary to sustain populations of migratory species and are under some form of cooperation.

4. A **Park for Peace** is a special designation that may be applied to any of the three types of Transboundary Conservation Areas and is dedicated to the promotion, celebration, and/or commemoration of peace and cooperation.
