

Approach and location

You get to Regensburg

- By plane via the airports of Munich (85 km) and Nuremberg (110 km). From there you can take a shuttle directly to Regensburg.

- By train via the central station of Regensburg
- By bus or by car via the Highway A 3 (Köln - Frankfurt – Nürnberg – Regensburg – Passau – Wien) , the highway A 93 (München – Regensburg – Weiden – Hof – Dresden) and via the parkway B8, B15 and B16

The historical halls are located in the historic city center of Regensburg and are therefore only accessible for delivery vehicles at certain times. But there are enough parking spaces and parking garages around the city center, which you can easily reach from following highway exits:

- A 93 - Regensburg- Pfaffenstein (exit 93) : parking area Dultplatz toward city center (Dom), Dultplatz is signposted, free of charge
Attention: the Dultplatz is not available as a parking area during the time of Dult (fair)
- A 93 – Regensburg- Prüfening (exit 41): parking garages at Bismarckplatz and Arnulfplatz
toward city center (Dom), the parking garages are signposted
- A 3 – Regensburg-Klinikum / Universität (exit 100a): parking area Donaumarkt (only parking over short periods)
toward city center (Dom), straight ahead to the Donau

From the central station you will get to Kolpinghaus best by bus. You can take the lines 1, 2, 4, 6, 11 or 13 which start at the central station / Albertstraße and go straight to Dachauplatz. The bus stop is located in front of the historic museum.
