WHY THIS PROJECT?

- to initiate a common project within the network
- to value the Junior Ranger programme on European level

WHAT WE WOULD LIKE YOU TO DO IN 5 STEPS:

1. brainstorm with your Junior Rangers to identify the most endangered habitats and relevant threatened species in your protected area
2. research and investigate on this habitat and species with the Junior Rangers (*what's the problem and what can/should be done?*)
3. figure out and plan what Junior Rangers could do to address this issue (*solutions*)
4. take concrete actions with the Junior Rangers to conserve identified species and habitat
5. monitor/assess the impact of your action



NB: this should be **part of your regular Junior Ranger programme** and involve JRs as much as possible!

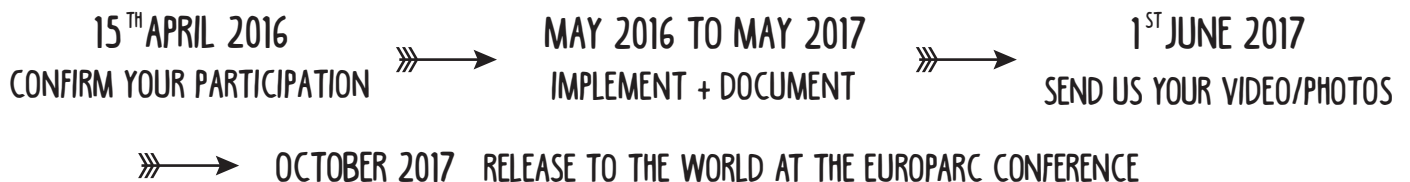
WHAT WE WOULD LIKE TO SHOW:
