WHY THIS PROJECT?

to initiate a common project within the network to value the Junior Ranger programme on European level

WHAT WE WOULD LIKE YOU TO DO IN 5 STEPS:

- 1. brainstorm with your Junior Rangers to identify the most endangered habitats and relevant threatened species in your protected area
- 2. research and investigate on this habitat and species with the Junior Rangers (what's the problem and what can/should be done?)
- 3. figure out and plan what Junior Rangers could do to address this issue (solutions)
- 4. take concrete actions with the Junior Rangers to conserve identified species and habitat
- 5. monitor/assess the impact of your action



NB: this should be part of your regular Junior Ranger programme and involve JRs as much as possible!

WHAT WE WOULD LIKE TO SHOW:

- how Junior Rangers are engaged in their protected area and what they do along those 5 steps
- how both Junior Rangers & Rangers or mentors benefit from the programme
