


The Cairngorms Connect project area




- 60,000ha of contiguous land
- From 200m ASL to 1300m ASL (2nd highest summit in Britain)
- The 4 partners have full management control
- Damaged by historic forestry, grazing and sporting management.





The Cairngorms Connect vision for habitat restoration is unparalleled in its scope, scale and timeframe, in the UK, extending to 60,000ha of native pinewood, moorland blanket bog and sub-Arctic montane habitats. Over the next 200 years we will:

- restore native woodlands to their natural limits, including high-altitude montane woodland;
- restore blanket bog, bog woodlands, wetlands & rivers to a more naturally functioning state, and




















Bjåen – 1,100m asl Same latitude as Fair Isle



















Peatlands and mire habitats
