



- Pasvik-Inari cooperation continues bilaterally between Norway and Finland
 greetings to all of you from Tiia Kalske, Rolf Kollstrøm, Riina Tervo and Kirsi
 Ukkonen
- Øvre Pasvik national park's (NO) brand new visitor point, Gjøken, will be opened on June 17th. Visitor point was built in PAN – Phenomena of Arctic Nature -cross-border cooperation project funded by EU.
- Joint monitoring of brown bear population takes place for the 5th time during this summer. Results will be published in the beginning of year 2024
- We are **busy with birds:** waterfowl on Pasvik river are counted both in spring and in autumn, and birds will be ringed in the late summer. Norway won the friendly competition on number of observed bird species and individuals during guided bird trip
- Cross-border cooperation with schools is developing: Finnish pupils participated in brown bear DNA-lab given by Norwegian colleagues in Finland in spring. Also, Finnish pupils and their teacher will travel to intensive one-week-course on climate change, phenology and water topics held in autumn in Norway

- **Transparcnet meeting in June 2022 in Binntal and Devero**
- Second place for our women's team (2 Italians, 2 Swiss) at the Memorial Danilo Re competition in Cogne / Italy, organized by ALPARC (the Alpine Network of Protected Areas) in January 2023
- ***** First transboundary staff meeting in March 2023 in Binn (exchange in English)
- Finishing of Italian-Swiss Interreg project MINERALP (Mines and Minerals), including preparation of the visitor mine of Taglione and tour with picture show of microminerals with live music
- * "Parchi in città Nature Parks visit the City" with 10 parks from Piedmont, Valais and Berne in the city of Thun in June 2023
- Decision of the competent bodies of both parks for the re-qualification as Transboundary Park in 2024


- Bavarian Forest National Park was enlarged by approx. 700 ha to 24 945 ha
- in addition, the nature zone was extended to 75.37 % of its area
- in Šumava National Park, the zone without human intervention was enlarged to 42 % of its area
- together, the two parks cover an area of 47.5 thousand ha, where process protection has priority
- last year we completed three major Interreg projects
- in May, a new Interreg project Ecological effects of the return of wolves on the Šumava/Bavarian Forest ecosystem started
- in the Life Project Transboundary restoration of mires for biodiversity and landscape hydrology in Šumava and Bavarian Forest (8/2018 – 12/2024) are already 1250 ha restorations completed, 150 km ditches blocked, 25 km streams restored
- in winter 2022/23 both national parks did for the third time (after 2011 and 2017) a monitoring of the western capercaillie (*Tetrao urogallus*) the results are expected in autumn



- large fire in both NPs last summer (2022), more than 1000 ha
- intensive discussions concerning further management of both NPs, many research and monitoring projects focused on impact of the forest fires, post-fire monitoring, post-fire and post-bark beetle management and prevention of fires (fire safety)
- new directors of both National Park administrations appointed: Petr Kříž (CZ) and Uwe Borrmeister (DE)



- Officially part of the Transboundary Parks network since 6th of October 2022;
- In January 2023, the Administrative Court of Lille delivered its verdict regarding the Escaut Pollution case asking Tereos to pay 9 millions € for damages compensation to Walloonia; a documentary about this environmental disaster is now available;
- Experience of b-solutions expertise in order to help us to better identify the solutions for water governance on our territory.
- Applications to Interreg VI programme were submitted, waiting for the results which will greatly impact our future work plan.
