A protected area needs to be a full member of the Federation to apply for the Transboundary Parks Programme as long as the protected area is its own legal entity and has its own budget. A protected area that does not have its own legal entity can however also apply for the Transboundary Parks Programme if it is represented by its higher authority at the Federation (i.e. the higher authority needs to be a full member to the Federation for a protected area to receive the Transboundary Parks Certificate).
